TICKETS: Each exhibitor will receive **ONE** ticket to the Women's Day event. Please provide the Chamber with the name of that attendee no later than September 23. Tickets for additional booth attendants must be purchased at Chamber member ticket price of \$50.

REGISTRATION / SET-UP / REMOVAL: Registration opens at 11:30 am. Set-up must be complete by 11:00 am. All exhibits must remain intact until the event closes. Teardown and removal will begin at 4:00 pm.

BOOTH FEATURES: Each exhibitor will be furnished one 6' draped table, with chairs available upon request. You may bring your own supplies as well, please let us know what you plan to bring.

ELECTRIC: Electric can be provided for your booth. If you require electric, reserve this on the online registration.

CRATE/BOX STORAGE: Packing boxes should be stored under your draped table. A limited amount of storage space will be available for larger crates, etc.
